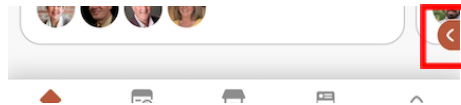

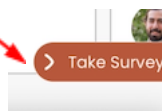

On any given page, you will see a small icon on the lower right side of the screen.



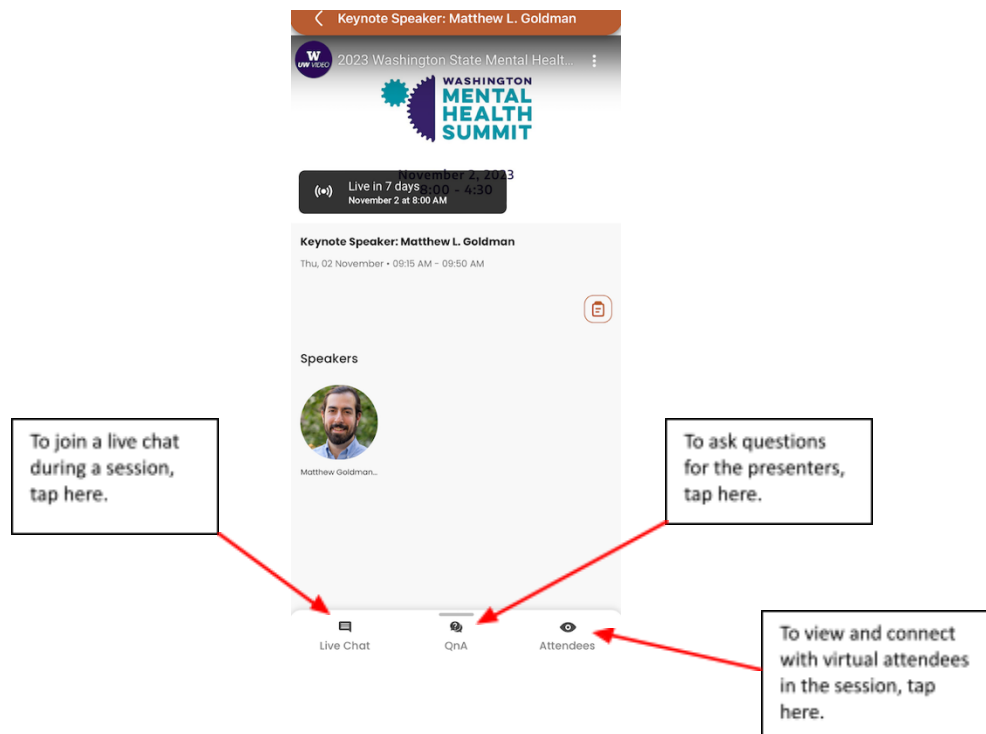
Tap the icon, then tap "Take Survey"
